Program Description

The Study in Portugal Network (SiPN) is a university consortium program developed by the Luso-American Foundation for Development (FLAD). It enjoys the support of the Portuguese government and US Embassy in Lisbon, the Fulbright Commission of Portugal and the City Council of Lisbon.

Facts

There are 2 summer sessions, June and July. A student can choose to take only one session or combine them;

Internships in many areas, 8 weeks minimum, (placements available in Portuguese OR English, part-time OR full-time);

Social science, Humanities, and Business majors are well-served, graduate students also welcome;

Design your own program with options available in English or Portuguese!

Portuguese language courses available at all levels;

Study and live in downtown Lisbon with other international students;

Live in a vibrant and safe European capital, near beautiful beaches and great restaurants!

If you choose Azores you will have the possibility to live in the “most beautiful place in the world” according to National Geographic.

Summer Programs Fees

Price based on number of credits, all transfer credits should be pre-approved prior to travel;

12 ECTS (6 US semester units) max per 4-week session, all ECTS credits from Portuguese universities;

\$ 3,550 for 12 ECTS credits (typically 6 US credits) each session;

\$ 2,800 for 6 ECTS credits (typically 3 US credits) each session.

Add an extra (6 ECTS) class per session for \$ 750

* Federal financial aid only applies for programs of 8 weeks or longer

** Students with FLAS grants are served the required 140 hours over 8 weeks.

What’s included?

Tuition fees;

Housing (single or double room, shared bathrooms by gender);

Health and travel insurance;
24/7 on-site support;

Lisbon transport card (metro, bus, trolleys);

Airport arrival, transfer and welcome orientation package;

Welcome and farewell dinners plus some group meals;

Two cultural and social excursions outside of Lisbon per session, with at least 1 overnight stay;

A Portuguese SIM card for unlocked GSM phones, pre-paid with basic 4G data plan

SiPN alums also enjoy priority access to a

Fulbright grant to Portugal (all areas) for those who eventually apply and qualify as finalists.

Students who apply for courses in the Azores may receive extra grant support through another FLAD program.

SiPN/FLAD scholarships deadline is March 15.

Azores (Summer Program)

São Miguel Island (course offerings subject to change)

All the courses can be combined to a max of 12 ECTS and the June Session in the Azores can also be combined with the July Session in Lisbon

All the courses include several guided tours of São Miguel Island and a weekend-long trip to Santa Maria

Island, as well as welcome and farewell dinners, plus some other group meals.

Portuguese Language Classes

Beginner and Intermediate Level,

Azorean Literature, History and Culture

(6 ECTS, 42 hrs) Afternoons;
Prof. Deolinda Adão - **UC Berkeley**

This course provides a panoramic view of Azorean culture and will explore emblematic works of Azorean literature within their appropriate historical context.

Ecology of the Azores Islands

(6 ECTS, 42hrs) Afternoons;
Prof. Erik Zettler - **NIOZ Royal Netherlands Institute for Sea Research & Utrecht University**

This course provides a panoramic view of Azorean Natural Heritage and will explore emblematic aspects of Azorean biodiversity and environment.

Students considering either of these classes are encouraged to choose both, since many of the site visits will overlap with the course content covered in each option.

Island Literature

(6 ECTS, 42hrs) Afternoons;
Prof. Vincent Barletta - **Stanford University**

This course explores the island as both a location plus the motif for major works of literature.



Summer Internship Program

1 – 31
July

Unpaid internships for academic credit

Part-Time (6 ECTS) or Full-Time (12 ECTS). Both options require an 8-week commitment, Full time internships cannot be combined with other courses.

SiPN has developed dozens of internships for academic credit in Portugal. Credit transfer depends on your home university's approval. The internships are offered for either English or Portuguese speakers in for-profits and non-; governmental and NGOs, and in various disciplinary areas:

- STEM fields
- Arts and Humanities
- International Business
- Social Science
- Fine arts

In addition to the practical work, the student will also be integrated into a class led by the SiPN Experiential Learning Coordinator.
